

The next edition of 'CEO for One Month' will be launched on February 2018. As a first step, candidates can apply to become 'CEO for One Month' of Adecco in their country of residence through the website https://www.adeccowaytowork.com/en/ceo-for-onemonth/phase-1/.

The selected CEO for each country will spend one month alongside the Country Adecco CEO; working with the local senior management team and facing a series of tests and assessments.

From amongst all of the country `CEOs for One Month', only one will be selected to become the Global 'CEO for One Month' of the Adecco Group!
